

Get Raider Ready: Complete Before SOU Campus Arrival

Below is a list of tasks to complete before you begin at SOU. Please reach out if you have any questions.

Attend a Raider Ready: Campus Connection event and a Virtual Registration Appointment. View scheduled events on our Orientation page. Prior to attending, check your SOU email for important updates including setting up your specific advising appointment time.
Send us a photo for your student ID. Before your Virtual Registration Appointment, email a personal photo along with your first name, last name, and student ID number to studentaccounts@sou.edu . The photo should be similar to a driver's license photo (it can be a selfie!). <i>Please note, this email must come from your SOU account</i> .
Update current mailing address. Log into InsideSOU, select "Personal Information". Review the address, if you need to update an address, select the "edit" button (pencil icon).
Sign-Up for Housing at <u>sou.edu/housing.</u> All first-year students (newly graduated from high school) are required to live on-campus for their first year at SOU. Check your email daily to receive information on Self-Selection (picking your room online) and more. Contact the University Housing Office at 541.552.6371 or housing@sou.edu with any questions.
Review and accept your Financial Aid Terms & Conditions. Log into your Banner account and log into InsideSOU. Click "Financial Aid Awards" then choose "Accept/Decline Awards". Read and accept the Terms and Conditions. You must also complete your Master Promissory Note (MPN) and Entrance Counseling (EC) found in this section.
Get your textbooks. As soon as you are registered for classes, you can order your textbooks through our <u>online bookstore</u> . Books can also be delivered to your home address. Be sure to check out all the great Raider gear when you come to campus!
Get a parking permit and/or bus pass. You can purchase a parking permit <u>online</u> . To get a Student Bus Pass, head to Raider Student Services or email <u>registrar@sou.edu</u> .
Download the Navigate Student app . Find the <i>Navigate Student</i> app in the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u> . With the Navigate Student app you will receive important reminders concerning university dates, forming study groups, viewing your class schedule, and connecting with your advisor or professors.
Stay safe with Campus Public Safety . Sign up for <u>SOU Alerts</u> to receive notifications about campus closures, emergencies, weather advisories, and more.
